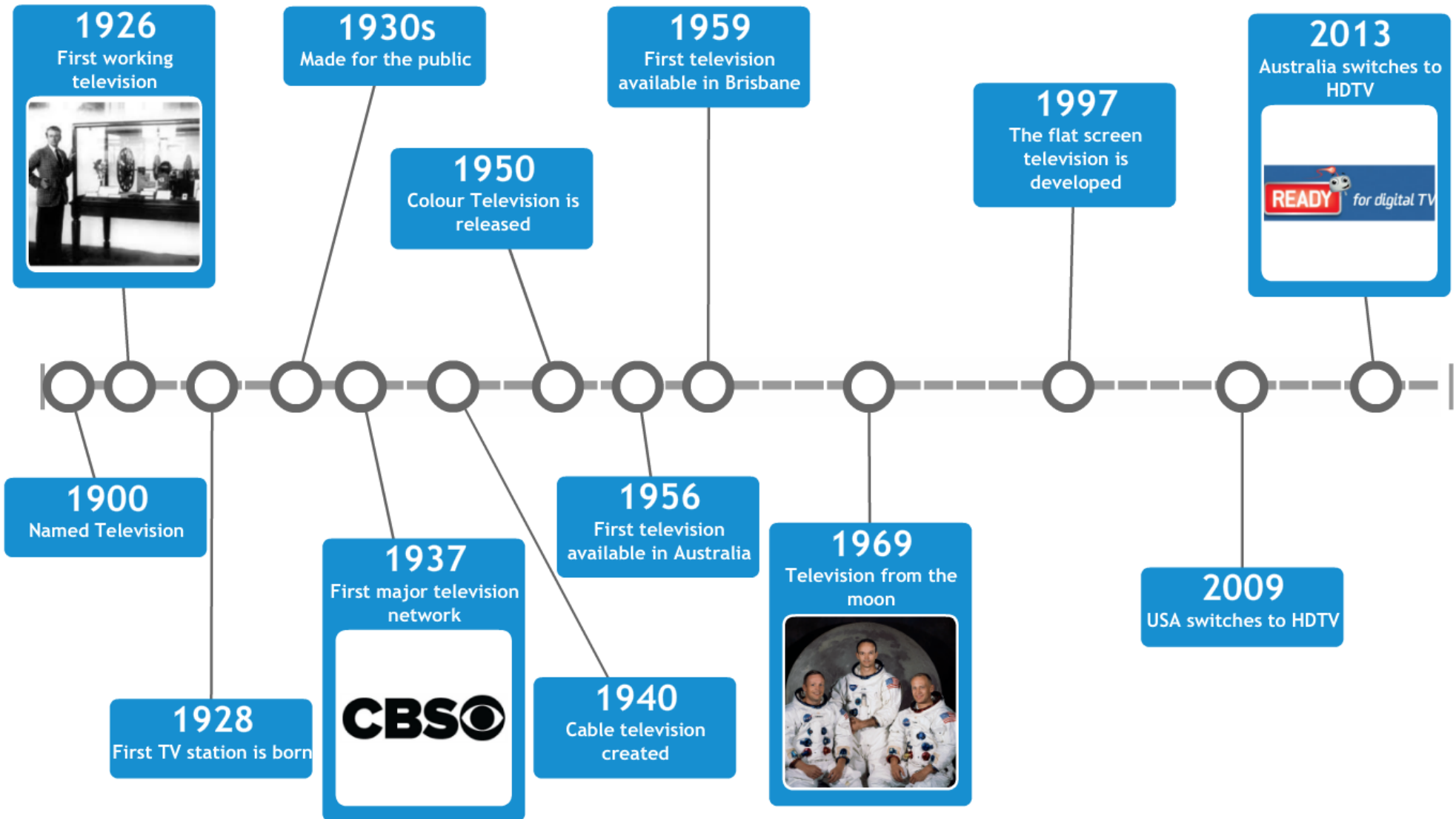

Items:

- **1900**
The first 'television' was seen at the 1900 World Fair in Paris.
- **1926**
John Logie- Bard demonstrated first working television.
- **1928**
The first TV station was owned by Charles Jenkins and was called W3XK.
- **1930s**
Television becomes accessible to the public and is both factual and entertaining.
- **1937**
CBS was the first major television network
- **1940**
John Walson creates cable television in Mahanoy City, Pennsylvania to provide television with poor reception
- **1950**
Colour television had been in development for years, however it wasn't released until the 1950s.
- **1956**
First televisions were made available in Sydney and Melbourne
- **1959**
Television available to Brisbane in Australia
- **1969**
The whole world world watched through their televisions as Neil Armstrong set foot on the moon.
- **1997**
Panasonic develops and releases the flat screen television
- **2009**
America makes the switch to all-digital television viewing
- **2013**
Australia makes the switch to all-digital television viewing
